The latest update for Flashtool is now available! This release brings with it a number of important changes, including compatibility updates for the following devices: Nokia Lumia 830 HTC M9 OnePlus One LG G4 (D821) Sony Xperia Z5 Premium... and more!

FlashTool is an open source system designed to allow you to change your firmware quickly and easily. The program can be compiled in any environment supporting C++ 11. It requires Qt 4.7+, Qwt 6+ and Boost 1.46+. Support for Windows XP has been discontinued in the latest release. If you still need to use XP then please use FlashTool version 0.9.15.0. FlashTool consists of two major components: the GUI and the driver. The GUI allows you to perform all operations related to flashing in an intuitive way, while the driver enables communicating with your device using the standard Mass Storage protocol. This driver currently supports a wide range of devices, including Android based phones and tablets, as well as Samsung Galaxy/Note/Tab series of phones and tablets, which includes Nexus devices. Support for new devices is constantly being added through continuous development on FlashTool project.

FlashTool is distributed under GPLv3+ license. It is available for Windows and Mac OS X 64-bit platforms. FlashTool can be compiled from source on Linux/Unix systems with Qt 4.7+ and Qwt 6+, but to avoid possible issues with missing dependencies, it is strongly recommended to use a precompiled binary distribution. FlashTool packages are available for both Debian and Ubuntu Linux. They are also recommended for other Linux or Unix based systems, including FreeBSD. The following versions of FlashTool are available:

For more information on the development of FlashTool see <https://flashtool.org/>. FlashTool v2.1, the first official release of FlashTool, was released on May 21, 2014. FlashTool v2.1 is based on Qt 5 and Qwt 6 and contains many improvements and new features:

It has the following new features:

The FlashTool v0.9.15 release was developed using Visual Studio 2012 and Qt 4.8, so it does not work on Windows XP or Windows Vista machines due to missing Qt DLLs for those two OSes. On newer systems, FlashTool will automatically use the 64 bit driver if a 64 bit OS is detected, otherwise it will use a 32 bit driver. The current version is 0.9.
